

Ratan Tata Sir, is an Industrialist, Investor, Philanthropist and a trained pilot. He was awarded Padma Shri and Padma Vibhushan. He was given the title of 'Sir- Honorary Knight' in London, UK.

Under Ratan Tata's Service, Tata Group has **exceeded its revenue by 40 times** and **profit exceeded to 50 times**. The greatness of Ratan Tata is that <u>he converts every deep insult to a steep result</u>.

90% Indian startups fail within 5 years of inspection and this Tata Group has sustained over 150 years. Today Tata Group is so big and expanded that more than 100 companies are operated in more than 100 countries. It has the highest Market Capitalisation. (TCS is bigger than the Pakistan Stock Exchange). Tata Group is contributing 4% to GDP. Tax for one year is about ₹ 47,195 Cores.

Ratan Tata Sir was born on 28th December 1937. He studied at Cornell University and Harvard University, USA. When he came back to India, his first job was at Tata Steel at Jamshedpur. He lived with the workers, slept in the dormitory and ate food while being in the line at the cafeteria. In his leadership, he listed TCS. He listed Tata Motors in the New York stock exchange so that it can get international power and recognition. As a chairmen of Tata he bought many foreign companies such as Tetly, Dafwoo, Corus, Jaguar and Land rover etc.

Ratan Tata Sir always rewards the Failure. He asked to try frugally and fail fast. He said, "Failure is the gold mine for the company". He had even launched an annual contest for failure in the Tata Group. He said -Small failure will spark your innovation.

At 26/11 Taj Attack, he had compensated their employees and given them medical counsellor for their whole life. To the employees who had lost their life, he gave their compensation to their family, given the whole salary of that person and moreover he had taken the responsibilities of their children's education, marriage and health. He even compensated the trainees in the same way who had newly joined and worked for a day. Not only he had compensated his employees but also to the police men who were injured, to the pedestrian, to the hawkers etc. This all was done in under 20 days.

Ratan Tata **donates 66% of his income** in *health, nutrition, Education, Water conservation, disaster relief, scholarships* etc. He **donated 95 Crores to IIT Bombay** to **establish the Tata Center of Technology Designing**. In recent days, **he donated 1,500 Crores to fight Covid-19**.
